Singing Saints: The Middle School Choir is available for students interested in singing, drama and choreography. The Singing Saints will present a musical, participate in the ACSI Vocal Music Festival, and perform during the Fine Arts Concerts. Students in this ensemble also have the opportunity to perform on-stage at Walt Disney World for Singabration in February. This ensemble will focus on singing skills, note reading, and ensemble techniques. This course is a year long elective.

Intermediate Strings: This course is a full year music elective for students playing stringed instruments; violin, viola, and cello will play in the large ensemble. Note reading, technical skills, and ensemble techniques will be the focus of the class. The string class will perform in chapel and Fine Arts Night. One day per week will focus on the development of advanced rhythmic studies through the use of multiple percussion instruments. Students must have at least one year of playing experience on a stringed instrument before joining the class. Teacher may ask student to audition. This course is a year long elective.

Beginning Band: A full year music elective available to those with no prior playing experience on a woodwind, brass instrument, or percussion instrument or on bass guitar. The band will perform concerts in January and May. Band members will have the opportunity to participate in a solo/ensemble festival held in Naples in March. Students will be counseled on their choice of instrument based on physical attributes such as tooth structure, lips, arm length, and hand size. Parents will be able to rent an instrument from the school or local music store in mid-September.
