



Elementary Improvement Plan 2009-2010

Theme: “Growing Real Relationships”

Academic: to identify the fundamental traits of an effective teacher and bring a higher level of academic accountability to the academy.

1. Identify and communicate a list of descriptive qualities of an effective teacher
2. Utilize an evaluative tool for assessing teacher effectiveness
3. Schedule time during Team/Faculty Meetings to share strategies for “Best Practices”
4. Improve teacher effectiveness in Math instruction by providing resources for Math Enrichment and Math review (Continental Math League/Mountain Math)
5. Improve teacher effectiveness in Science instruction by providing professional development training in Creation Science and the adoption of new textbook series
6. Provide opportunities for Faculty/Staff Development

Spiritual: to define, practice, and model spiritual disciplines as a means of strengthening our relationship to God and others

1. Identify the Spiritual Disciplines to be taught at FBA through the ASP project
2. Utilize Evaluation Tool to guide the process for implementation of ASP project
3. Introduce the Spiritual Disciplines in the Elementary school by defining them during monthly themed chapels & classroom instruction
4. Document the modeling of the Spiritual Disciplines in the Elementary school by teacher example through curriculum, drama, music and art
5. Document the practice of the Spiritual Disciplines through planned classroom activities, field experiences, chapels, teacher/student coaching, class ministry projects, and school-wide activities

Relational: to plan, develop and initiate a strategy to strengthen interpersonal relationships.

1. Implement a school-wide theme to communicate the focus of “Growing Real Relationships”
2. Provide the Biblical foundation on which healthy God/Christ-centered relationships can develop, grow and flourish
3. Formulate a strategic plan founded on the principles of Kingdom Education to strengthen relationships among individuals and groups represented by the home, the church and the school
