## FALL

- ❖ Take the PSAT
- ❖ Take a career assessment test, to assist in your career decisions
- ❖ Create an account on [www.fastweb.com](http://www.fastweb.com) and on [www.schoolsoup.com](http://www.schoolsoup.com). Both websites will email you scholarship information
- ❖ Consider the CLEP test

## WINTER

- ❖ Collect financial aid information and admission requirements for colleges that you are interested in attending
- ❖ Register to take the SAT and the ACT
- ❖ Get an SAT and an ACT preparation booklet from your Guidance Counselor and start preparing for the tests

## SPRING

- ❖ Take the ACT ([www.act.org](http://www.act.org)) and the SAT ([www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com))
- ❖ Start visiting colleges and take campus tours
- ❖ Collect applications from colleges of interest
- ❖ Register with the NCAA Clearinghouse eligibility center. (You must register if you plan on playing college level sports with an NCAA school)
- ❖ When taking the ACT or SAT, request test scores to be sent to the eligibility center (the code is "9999")
- ❖ Begin your amateurism questionnaire on the NCAA Clearinghouse website
- ❖ Ask your teachers to write recommendation letters

## SUMMER

- ❖ After your junior year, have your high school guidance counselor send a copy of your transcript to the NCAA Clearinghouse. If you have attended any other high schools, make sure a transcript is sent to the eligibility center from each high school
