-Student must be son/daughter or grandchild of a Marine, 2.0 GPA participation in community, school activities and athletics evaluated. Financial need, IRS tax form required. Essay on attribute or accomplishment and why student wants a college education.

Marine Corps League- E.T. Brisson Detachment # 063- 3 @ \$500

-Student must have Marine Corps lineage, financial need, 3.0 GPA, demonstrated leadership ability. Essay on Marine Corps lineage and leadership.

Naples Memorial VFW Post 7369 Stanley Lapinski Scholarship- \$varies

-Veteran or child/grandchild of veteran, financial need, US citizen, school and community service. Essay on why student loves the US.

Air Force ROTC High School Scholarship Program- \$varies

- provides 3- and 4-year scholarships in three different types to high school seniors. The application process is the same for each type. Application available at www.afrotc.com.

Army ROTC High School Scholarship Program- \$ varies

-The high school Four-Year Scholarship is for high school students planning on attending a four-year college program. Contact your high school academic advisor or Campus Military Science department for more information. To qualify, you must: be a U.S. citizen, be between the ages of 17 and 26, have a high school CGPA of at least 2.50, have a high school diploma or equivalent, score minimum of 920 on the SAT (math/verbal) or 19 on the ACT (excluding the required writing test scores), meet physical standards, agree to accept a commission and serve in the Army on Active Duty or in a Reserve Component (U.S. Army Reserve or Army National Guard).
