**Immunizations:**

Florida law requires that every child present valid immunization records and proof of physical evaluation prior to admittance or attendance in a Florida school. This applies to all students in pre-kindergarten through the twelfth grade, including those students with special problems up to the age of twenty-two. **You must always present a Florida Certificate of Immunization, either DH or HRS form 680-Part A, B, or C that identifies the age appropriate immunizations required for your child to attend school.**

**Health Examination:**

The “Florida Plan for School Health Services” also requires that all students (PK-12), including those new to the state and those entering pre-kindergarten or kindergarten classes for the first time, provide documentation of a Student Health Examination performed within the **12 months prior** to initial entry into a Florida school. **A student health examination (DH or HRS-H form 3040) must be completed and signed by a licensed practicing health care provider and presented to the school at the time of registration.** An appointment card showing a scheduled physical is **not acceptable.**

**Safety Form:**

It’s the law! Emergency information cards must be completed and signed by each child’s parent or guardian every year. Please notify our school office with any address or telephone number changes that occur throughout the year so that our records will remain current.

## IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 2007-2008

- 4 Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (DTP/DTaP)
- 3 or 4 Haemophilus Influenza Type B (HIB)
- 3 Hepatitis B (HepB)
- 3 Polio
- 1 Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR)
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)-or show health record of chicken pox illness.

**GRADES KINDERGARTEN - 6TH:**

- 5 Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (DTP/DTaP)
- 4 Polio
- 3 Hepatitis B (HepB)
- 2 Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR)
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)-or show health record of chicken pox illness.

**GRADES 7 – 11 ENTRY:**

- 5 Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (DTP/DTaP)
- 4 Polio
- 3 Hepatitis B (HepB)
- 2 Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR)
- 1 Tetanus-Diphtheria Booster (Td)**
  - **Prior to entering 7th grade**
