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- Schedule conferences with parents or students as needed.
- Supervise extra-curricular activities, organizations and outings as assigned.
- Complete all requirements for ACSI certification.
- Maintain a close personal walk with the Lord evidenced by lifestyle.
- Observe the Matthew 18 principle in conflict resolution.
- Fulfill all duties as assigned by the school administration.
- Demonstrate a love for teaching and learning with enthusiasm.
- Maintain a clean, attractive classroom that is conducive to learning.
- Plan and implement biblically integrated lessons.

- Punctual in attendance to faculty meetings, devotions, and all assigned responsibilities.
- Available to assist others as needed, promoting unity.
- Display all levels of student artwork on a rotating schedule throughout the FBA campus.
- Represent FBA student artwork in the community.
- Participate in Art Festivals that will benefit FBA art students and community.
- Promote the Visual Arts department of FBA.
