
FBA ATHLETICS CLEARANCE FOR PARTICIPATION PROCEDURE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

All student-athletes **MUST** be a fully registered as a traditional or HSE student at FBA.

All required forms must be turned into the Athletic Office **PRIOR** to participation in practices, tryouts, workouts, competitions or summer camps.

Forms Required to Participate w/FBA Athletics

→ EL2 SPORTS -PRE-PARTICIPATION PHYSICAL EVALUATION

- ◆ Valid for 365 days
- ◆ Signed by a licensed physician, osteopathic physician, chiropractic physician, PA, or a RN

→ EL3 -CONSENT & RELEASE LIABILITY CERTIFICATE

- ◆ Valid for 365 days
 - ◆ Covers a Release of Liability for FBA & FHSAA from all liability from injury or claim resulting from participation
 - Includes insurance information from family
 - If no insurance- FBA/FBCN secondary insurance policy will replace
 - ◆ Covers Release of Liability for Concussions
 - Athlete & Parent/Guardian acknowledges he/she have read and are aware of the signs & symptoms of a concussion & release procedures that accompany being diagnosed with a concussion
 - ◆ Consent & Release for Liability - Sudden Cardiac Arrest & Heat Related Illness
 - Athlete & Parent/Guardian acknowledge they have read and are aware of the signs & symptoms of Sudden Cardiac Arrest & Heat-Related Illnesses
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→ **ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT**

- ◆ Valid for 365 days
- ◆ This form is used to confirm the student-athlete & parent/guardian have read and understand the Athlete Code of Conduct and agree to its principles and guidelines at all sporting events
- ◆ Handbook is available for viewing on the athletics page of the www.fbalions.org website

→ **GA4 - AFFIDAVIT OF COMPLIANCE IN REGARDS TO RECRUITING**

- ◆ Required from any student-athlete who has either transferred **OR** started school at FBA after already starting school somewhere else (i.e., 7th, 10th, 11th, or 12th- including HSE Students) **OR** is a non-traditional student {FBA HSE Program}
 - This includes changing schools over the summer
 - Exceptions are: not required from students who are entering the first day of school from a terminating grade 5th to 6th or 8th to 9th
- ◆ Form must be notarized
- ◆ Needs only to be done once
- ◆ Must be signed by the student-athlete & parent/guardian
- ◆ This form defines what is athletic recruiting & impermissible benefits are
- ◆ Certifies that the proper paperwork has been submitted to the athletic office prior to participation in practices, tryouts, workouts, and competitions
- ◆ Certifies that no employee, athletic department staff member, representative of the athletic interests of FBA, any person or organization acting on their behalf or a third party is giving, has given, has offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly, through intermediaries, or otherwise any impermissible benefit to THIS STUDENT or any member of his/her family for the purpose of participation in interscholastic athletics

Forms Required to Participate w/FBA Athletics From Home School Extension Students

A homeschooled student cannot register intent at more than one school at a time. If a student is taking 50% or more of his/her classes at a single school, public or private, or an online service other than Florida Virtual School, or any other school that has a Department of Education Number, then the student will not be eligible to participate in athletics at FBA. He or she would be deemed a student at the school where 50% or more of classes are being taken.

NOTE: Students who are dual enrolled or early admission students with a college or university are considered "Traditional Students" and are ineligible to be registered as a homeschool student.

ALL OF THE ABOVE APPLY + THE FOLLOWING:

→ EL7 FORM- REGISTRATION FORM FOR HOME EDUCATION STUDENTS

- ◆ Completed and returned to athletic office by assigned FHSAA deadline date
- ◆ Needs only to be done once- following years a EL7V is required
- ◆ Must be signed by both student-athlete & parent
- ◆ Must be notarized and signed by the CCPS Home Education Office and hold their seal
- ◆ Student-athlete should list all sports he/she may be interested in participating with on this form as it is used to submit eligibility data to the FHSAA via Home Campus for participation approval {even if you think you may not participate in a certain sport, still list it, you may change your mind and it would be too late to submit to FHSAA leaving you not eligible to participate in that sport}
- ◆ A transcript of record of grades must accompany to insure student is academically eligible to participate in athletics. A 2.0 GPA is required on a 4.0 scale
 - Students entering 6th grade for the first time need not submit any transcript or record of grades until the conclusion of the first semester. Then a EL9 form will be required

OR

→ EL7V FORM- VERIFICATION OF STUDENT REGISTRATION WITH CCPS HOME EDUCATION OFFICE

- ◆ Must be completed annually
- ◆ This form is used by those who have previously registered with CCPS Home Education Office to confirm registration is still valid
- ◆ Must be signed by the CCPS Home Education Office and hold their seal stating student is registered with CCPS
- ◆ A transcript of record of grades must accompany to insure student is academically eligible
 - Students entering 6th grade for the first time need not submit any transcript or record of grades until the conclusion of the first semester. Then a EL9 form will be required
