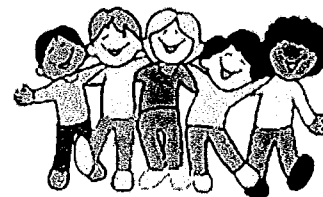

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

All children must have a fully-completed Florida Certificate of Immunization (Form DH 680) at time of registration.

At the time of initial enrollment or registration, students entering a Florida school for the first time must provide a valid physical examination.

- Either 1 varicella vaccination (chickenpox), or
 - Documentation by a healthcare provider that the child has had the chickenpox illness

*Number depends on immunization history

- The physical must have been completed in the U.S.
- The date of the physical exam must be within 12 months of the child's first day of school.
- Students who cannot provide proof of a valid physical examination may not attend school until they can provide the necessary information required on the Florida form DH 3040.
- An appointment card from a local physician or clinic showing that a physical examination is scheduled to be completed at a later date is **not acceptable**.
- **For Head Start Only** – Physical evaluation must include a current blood hemoglobin level and lead level.
- Physical examinations can be obtained from your physician, health care provider, or a walk-in clinic before registering your child. A list of clinics and pediatricians is available at your child's school or by calling 377-0514 or 377-0110.

School Health Entry Requirements 2018-2019

A **PHYSICAL EXAM**, signed by a licensed healthcare provider and dated within 12 months of the child's first day of school is required for each student initially entering a Florida school.
